## **Advanced training**

- Aims to allow trainees to focus on a subspecialty
- 1 year in duration
- Can be taken as 1 subspecialty year or split into two 6 month blocks
- Will not necessarily happen in year 7 e.g. an OOP may occur prior to this
- Some advanced posts are competitive and must be applied for

## Available advanced units

(6-12 months duration each)

- Cardiothoracics
- Neurosurgery
- Paediatrics
- Pain
- Obstetrics
- ICM (as part of the ICM training programme)
- General duties including 1 or more of: airway, ENT, Max/Facs, general/uro/gynae, hepatobiliary, vascular, day surgery, sedation, orthopaedics, regional, trauma, transfer, plastics/burns

## Out of Programme (OOP) time

- Time out of programme may be undertaken anytime in ST3-7
  (NB: For OOP to count towards training final FRCA must have been completed)
- Six months notice to the school is imperative
- Trainees must be back in a school post 6 months prior to CCT
